Infoladen

Access

The Infoladen is only accessible via a 4 cm high step. The entrance door is 85 cm wide.

Bar

No bar available. The room has a kitchen with a 94 cm high countertop and a table with information materials (70 cm high). There are bookshelves of various heights.

Seating

There is one table that is wheelchair-accessible from the short ends, as well as a small step stool.

Toilets

No toilet available.

Sensory Environment and Atmosphere

The room contains many books and posters and feels quite full, with lots of visual stimuli. It has one small window but many lamps. The room is generally cool.

Innenhof

Access

The Innenhof can be reached through the large entrance gate (several metres wide) between the Vorplatz and the Innenhof. The ground is made of cobblestones and is quite uneven. The Innenhof is only partially protected from rain.

Seating

There are usually tables and chairs in the Innenhof. There are also large flower planters made from car tyres (approx. 60 cm high) that can be used for seating.

Toilets

No toilets available.

Sensory Environment and Atmosphere

It is often noisy, with sounds coming from the surrounding rooms. There are often many people and a lot of sensory input.

Kino

Access

The Kino is only accessible over cobblestone paving. The entrance is several metres wide. A small section of the seating is raised and can only be reached via steps. The rest of the room is level. There is sufficient space next to the front rows for

wheelchair users to watch the film. The aisles on either side of the seating rows are 80 cm wide at their narrowest point. The floor is made of cobblestones.

Bar

The bar counter is 123 cm high and has five bar stools.

Seating

There are approximately 80 seats, including cinema seats and sofas (1.8 m wide). During screenings, the edges of the seating rows are marked with rope lighting.

Toilets

The toilet is located in another room. The key is available at the bar. The toilet door is 80 cm wide, with a 98 cm wide access corridor. The sink is 93 cm high. Inside the toilet cubicle there is a shower, which is accessed via a 24 cm high step. This is a single, gender-neutral cubicle.

Sensory Environment and Atmosphere

The room has no windows and is generally cool. The lighting is dimmed during screenings.

Other

There are several pillars in the room that people may accidentally bump into.

Queerfeministischer Raum

Access

The room is located on the first floor and has a wheelchair lift (maximum load: 250 kg). However, the lift is only accessible over cobblestones and can only be operated with assistance from the team (no Eurokey access). There is a threshold at the entrance where a ramp can be installed.

The evacuation routes are not wheelchair accessible. There is no fire-protected refuge area.

Stage

The stage is raised and can be accessed via a mobile ramp (85 cm wide, 22% / 12.5° incline).

Bar

The bar counter is 117 cm high. There is no lowered section at seated height, but the side is open and service is possible at a lower height.

Seating

There are several bar stools as well as many different sofas.

Toilets

There are two toilet cubicles. The larger cubicle measures 160 × 125 cm, and the door is 80 cm wide. A folding support rail is installed on the left-hand side. The lock on the cubicle doors requires fine motor skills to operate. Menstrual products are available. There is no baby changing table.

Sensory Environment and Atmosphere

The room has many windows and is well lit. It becomes very hot during the summer.

Other

During No Borders No Nations, the OfR can be used as a quiet space for people who need to withdraw from sensory overload.

Vorplatz

Access

The Vorplatz is wheelchair accessible from the railway station. Most of the surface is level concrete, with a few areas covered in gravel.

Seating

There are benches, stones, and steps available for seating.

Toilets

There are urinals and small cubicles for free-standing urination. The cubicles are labelled "Frauen*-Pissoir." There are no grab rails, menstrual products, or baby changing table. A wheelchair-accessible ToiToi will be available on the Schützenmatte next to the other toilets (150 cm × 150 cm, with a grab rail).

Sensory Environment and Atmosphere

The area is noisy (train tracks, roads, many people). During No Borders No Nations, the Vorplatz hosts loud concerts. The area beneath the bridge is lit and protected from the rain.

Other

There may occasionally be broken glass or used syringes on the ground.

Schützenmatte

Access

The Schützenmatte is wheelchair accessible from the railway station. The surface is level concrete.

Bar

To be announced.

Toilets

A wheelchair-accessible ToiToi will be available on the Schützenmatte next to the other toilets (150 cm × 150 cm, with a grab rail).

Sensory Environment and Atmosphere

The Schützenmatte is noisy and has many sensory stimuli (train tracks, roads, many people). During No Borders No Nations, loud concerts take place here.

Other

There may occasionally be broken glass or used syringes on the ground.

Tojo Theater

Access

The Tojo Theater is only accessible over cobblestone paving. Inside, the floor is level and made of concrete. The backstage area is only accessible by stairs, and the area behind the bar is not wheelchair accessible.

Bar

The bar counter is high and not wheelchair accessible.

Seating

Many chairs are available. There are no sofas or wide seats.

Toilets

There is an accessible toilet with a grab rail. Menstrual products are available. There is no baby changing table. The toilets are gender-neutral. Signs outside the cubicles indicate which contain toilets and which contain urinals.
